

**TOWN OF KILLEN**  
**Council Meeting Minutes**  
**Tuesday, January 3, 2023 5:00 P.M.**

1) There being a quorum present, Mayor Tubbs called to order the regular meeting of the Town of Killen Council Meeting at 5:01 p.m. on Tuesday, January 3, 2023 at the Killen Town Hall.

2) Invocation was led by Council Member Charles Glover and The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Council Member Connie Parrish.

Council Member Glover made a motion to approve all the above items on the Consent Agenda. The motion was duly seconded by Council Member Parrish and on roll call the vote was as follows: AYE: Council Members Wright, Owens, Parrish, Glover, McGee, and Mayor Tubbs. NAY: None. The motion passed unanimously.

4) Approve Resolution 2023-01 TAP Project - Council Member Parrish made a motion to approve Resolution 2023-01 TAP Project. The motion was duly seconded by Council Member Owens and on roll call the vote was as follows: AYE: Council Members Wright, Owens, Parrish, Glover, McGee, and Mayor Tubbs. NAY: None. 5) Approve Ordinance 2023-01 An Ordinance Rezoning 1014 Lock Six Road from Single Family Residential to Highway Commercial – Council Member Wright made a motion to approve Ordinance 2023-01. The motion passed unanimously.

6) Approve to Accept Credit/Debit Card Payments to General Fund – Council Member Wright made a motion to approve the acceptance of credit/debit card payments into the general fund account . The motion was duly seconded by Council Member Glover and on roll call the vote was as follows: AYE: Council Members Wright, Owens, Parrish, Glover, McGee, and Mayor Tubbs. NAY: None. The motion passed unanimously.

7) Approve to Increase Meredith Renegar’s Hours to (29) Per Week - Council Member Parrish made a motion to increase senior center director Meredith Renegar’s hours from twenty-three hours per week to twenty-nine hours per week . The motion was duly seconded by Council Member Glover and on roll call the vote was as follows: AYE: Council Members Wright, Owens, Parrish, Glover, McGee, and Mayor Tubbs. NAY: None. The motion passed unanimously.

8) Other Business – Chief Bryan Hammond stated the Drug Take Back event was a success. Fire Chief Wayne McDuff informed the Council that an insurance claim had been filed for three sets of turnout gear that had been damaged as a result of a recent fire call. Updates on the Shelter Grant were also discussed.
